

Short Curriculum Vitae of Eugene Morozov

Doctor of Sciences in Physics and Mathematics (1990).

Head of Laboratory of hydrological processes at the Shirshov Institute of Oceanology (1993).

Eugene Morozov has been working at the Shirshov Institute since 1970.

The main fields of his research are internal waves and ocean circulation. He is a field oceanographer, and his work includes field measurements, data collecting, processing and analysis.

The recent scientific activity of E. Morozov is related to the flows in the abyssal channels of the Atlantic: Vema Channel, Romanche and Chain fracture Zones, Kane Gap, Vema Fracture Zone, and others.

Eugene Morozov is the author of 173 publications including four books.

Since 1969 E. Morozov made 38 cruises in the ocean including 25 cruises in the Atlantic, 4 cruises in the Indian, 4 cruises in the Pacific, 4 cruises in the Southern and one cruise in the Arctic Ocean. In many of them he was the leading scientist.

In 1999, Eugene Morozov was elected a member of the IAPSO Executive. In 2003, he was elected for the second term. In 2007, he was elected a vice-president of the IAPSO. In 2011 he was elected the President of IAPSO. He is also the Chairman of the Oceanographic Section at the Russian National Geophysical Committee, which is a Russian link to the IUGG.
