Matthias Huss is a glaciologist, both involved in direct field measurements and the modelling of cryospheric processes at the local to the global scale. His main research interests are the response of mountain glaciers to past and future climate change and the contribution of glaciers to runoff. Matthias Huss completed his PhD at the ETH Zürich, Switzerland, in 2009 and was then appointed Senior Lecturer at the University of Fribourg, Switzerland. Since 2013 he jointly holds a Senior Lecturer position also at the ETH Zürich. Since his first publication in 2007, Matthias Huss has published more than 60 peer-reviewed papers in various sub-disciplines of glaciology and hydrology. Besides other distinctions he has been awarded with the “*Young Investigator Award*” by the American Geophysical Union in 2013, and with the “*Arne Richter Award for outstanding young scientists*” by the European Geosciences Union in 2014.
